## Case Study: Teesside University

### Product: Active Track



#### Background

Awarded the Queen's Anniversary Prize 2014-18 for outstanding work in the field of enterprise and business engagement, Teesside University works with over 20,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students and employs over 2,000 staff.

More than £270 million has been invested in its town centre campus in the heart of Middlesbrough, providing top-class facilities to students.

#### The challenge

With the safety and security of a large number of students and staff needing to be maintained across the campus' different buildings, the security team at Teesside University were using a simple patrol recording system to produce reports. But, as an ageing system, which hadn't benefited from regular software updates, it was struggling to cope with the security team's growing requirements for a patrol system. The readers were failing more and more and were becoming increasingly costly to repair.

Security manager Stuart Jones said:

“As the university grew, our existing patrol systems were unable to develop with us and so there was increasing pressure being put on our security staff to fulfil their reporting duties.”

#### The solution

After researching more up-to-date models of patrol systems, Stuart got in touch with GuardTour about its Active Track system. This would provide the University with a robust platform which would give real time information as well as a number of other benefits.

Stuart said: “Active Track offers a vast improvement on our existing system because it allows us to analyse information in real time rather than later on once reports have been uploaded.
